

VISIT ON SITE: LT-PL/083: “JOINT DEVELOPMENT OF PUBLIC FIRE AND RESCUE SERVICES IN LITHUANIA –POLAND BORDERLINE AREA”

On 26th August 2010 the fire station in Druskinnikai was visited by the participants of the summer camp organized within the activities of the project LT-PL/083 “Joint development of public fire and rescue services in Lithuania-Poland borderline area” implemented in frames of the Lithuania-Poland CBC Programme. Representatives of the Joint Technical Secretariat were also present.



Project LT-PL/083 aims at increasing the efficiency of joint Lithuanian-Polish fire and rescue actions in the border area, through the development of sustainable cross-border cooperation between the municipalities on both sides of the border. Project will achieve its goals by establishing joint coordination system, organizing joint trainings for specialists, creating common standards in terms of equipment used by the fire brigades, as well as involving young people into preventive activities.

During the summer camp held in Lazdijaj the young participants had the opportunity to visit a fire brigade, learn about the daily work of a fireman and get acquainted with the equipment that he uses. Responsibilities and safety requirements in emergency situations were presented to the children.



Project LT-PL/083 is implemented by two partners on the Lithuanian side: Lazdijaj and Alytus district municipality administrations; as well as three Polish partners: Puńsk, Krasnopol and Płaska municipalities. Total value of the project is 822 855, 00 EUR, out of which 699 426, 75 EUR is to be financed from the European Regional Development Fund.
